- 3.) Team hunting for tokens, if you team hunt please only take one per team, we will use the honor system.
- 4.) As time passes, we will give out more clues to the whereabouts of the remaining tokens. Check daily to see if any reported tokens have been found.
- 5.) For those who find a token, please email meadowsmonster@gmail.com and identify the location of the found token and your name. We will then post on the Meadows Monster web site for fellow hunters to see. This will help hunters not to waste time on tokens already found.

Any of the tools listed below if carried at all times while practicing the Meadows Monster Challenge the will only increase your chance of coming to the race with a free entry (when redeemed).

Compass

Multi-tool or Knife & Screwdriver (s)

18 paces East and 15' up from the location shown in picture.

W 89 28.2558 : 15 paces North of Nest Box # 6

Coin # 5)

If you become intimate with me I can help you reflect on the past 9 mi.

I may be at the lowest point/altitude in the race.

Don't get caught in a trap as it will keep you from your goal.
